## POLICE NEWS

The Tempe police have assigned officer **Brian Ornealas** to strictly deal with Park Enforcement issues. It's the next best thing to bringing back the park ranger program.

They are also assigning 4 specially trained officers to be part of a mental health response squad. This is welcome news considering some of the recent headlines.

**Commander Noah Johnson** reported that there have been 7 burglaries in our neighborhood in the first 2 months of the year.
